
An Insight into the Current Camp Happenings

David Thompson Bible Camp

Purpose Statement: Our purpose is to share the gospel message with children of all ages and to help them build relationships with God and each other.

Meet the Board Chairman

Pastor Mike Hicks is the Board Chairman for David Thompson Bible Camp. He joined the camp board in 2009 when he and his wife Helen became the pastor at Wanham Bethel Chapel. He has been the Chairman for 9 ½ years (since September 2015). In addition to organizing and chairing board meetings, the chairman serves as an ex-officio member of all committees.



Seasonal Positions

Opportunities to serve at camp varies from one week to all summer. Here are a few of the Seasonal Positions at DTBC:

SENIOR CABIN LEADERS

are people who have a commitment to God and a working knowledge of the Bible. They are responsible for teaching the Bible and various camp skills including archery, canoeing, crafts, climbing wall, and rocketry, leading cabin devotions, and helping with general camper supervision. Must be over 18 years of age.

JUNIOR CABIN LEADERS

are people who are interested in learning more about being a senior cabin leader. They assist the senior leaders throughout the camp week with the various camp activities.

COOKS AND KITCHEN HELPERS

at least one Head Cook is required with, at least 2 or 3 helpers per week. Kitchen helpers assist the head cook in getting the meals ready, wash dishes and prepare the dining room for meal times.

WRANGLERS

are needed for camp weeks which offer horsemanship. They care for the horses, teach campers the basics of horse care and riding.

SPEAKERS

are people who are willing to be the spiritual leader for the week. They typically deliver 1-2 chapel messages per day. They must relate well to the respective age groups.

MAINTENANCE

needs to be done throughout the camping season just to keep the facilities operating smoothly. An individual with handy-man skills that can work unsupervised is ideal for this position.

MEDICAL PERSONNEL are people with an RN, EMS, or First Aid qualification.

The Ministry

David Thompson Bible Camp (DTBC) is a Christ-centered summer camp which was founded in 1961 near Fairview, Alberta. DTBC is affiliated with One Hope Canada. Although DTBC is a small camp, it has been blessed by the immeasurable generosity of many volunteers and donors, and is a testament to the faithfulness of God and His people. DTBC's purpose is to share the Gospel message with children of all ages and to lead them to a deeper relationship with God.

The Job

The role of Camp Director at DTBC is one that requires a heart for camp ministry, as well as the skills and knowledge required to administer the day-to-day operations of the camp. The Camp Director must be physically capable of assisting with maintenance issues, as well as participation in the daily operations of the camp. They must also have strong interpersonal skills, as they strive to develop, maintain, and expand public relations with summer missionaries, volunteers, local churches, and the general public. Dining Hall Replacement Update


